As Student Dining Worker and Event Staff, I served hot food, staffed special events and occasions repeatedly, and served student-run station in the Marketplace while maintaining strict quality, sanitation and food safety standards in alignment with ServSafe and state guidelines, with active prevention of cross-contamination, storage safety, and handwashing for gluten-free, vegan, halal, and our nut station. As Dining Worker, I served over 300 students per hour and upwards of 900 students per meal period during our busiest shifts, working highest demand stations and serving most popular items. Because of my reliability, I am consistently assigned to the highest-demand stations on the busiest-item nights to meet service demands.

I am a highly experienced worker at the Marketplace. In my time at Dining Services, I've trained 4 student workers on various stations, guiding two separate new hires through their first shifts on deli, one on salad bar, one on plat du jour, and various other training instances. In addition, I have kitchen and cold prep experience preparing vegetables and herbs. I've delivered customer service to many of these students in a high volume, fast-paced environment, consistently maintaining positive attitude, professional demeanor and resolving challenges like items being out of stock, time constraints, problems with food, preventing cross-contamination, dietary restrictions, and more.
